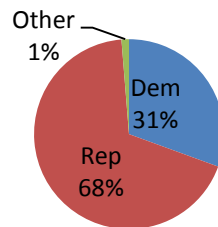

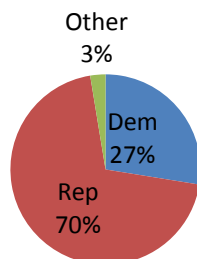

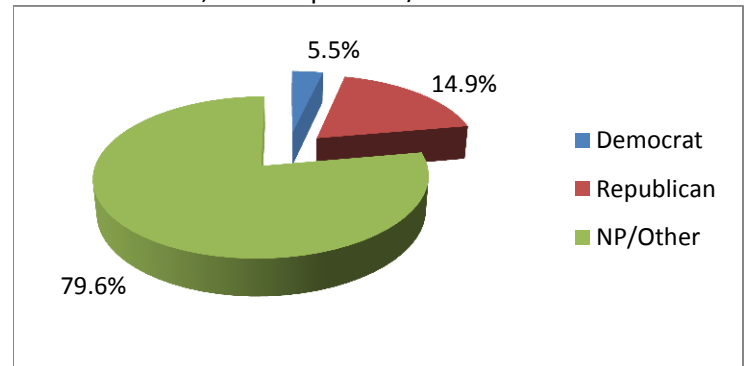

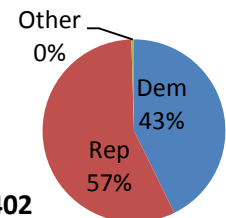

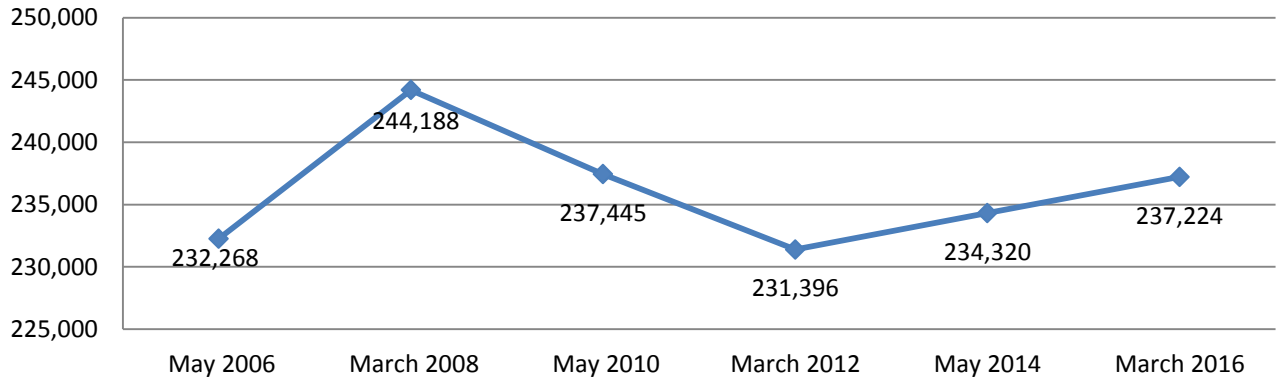

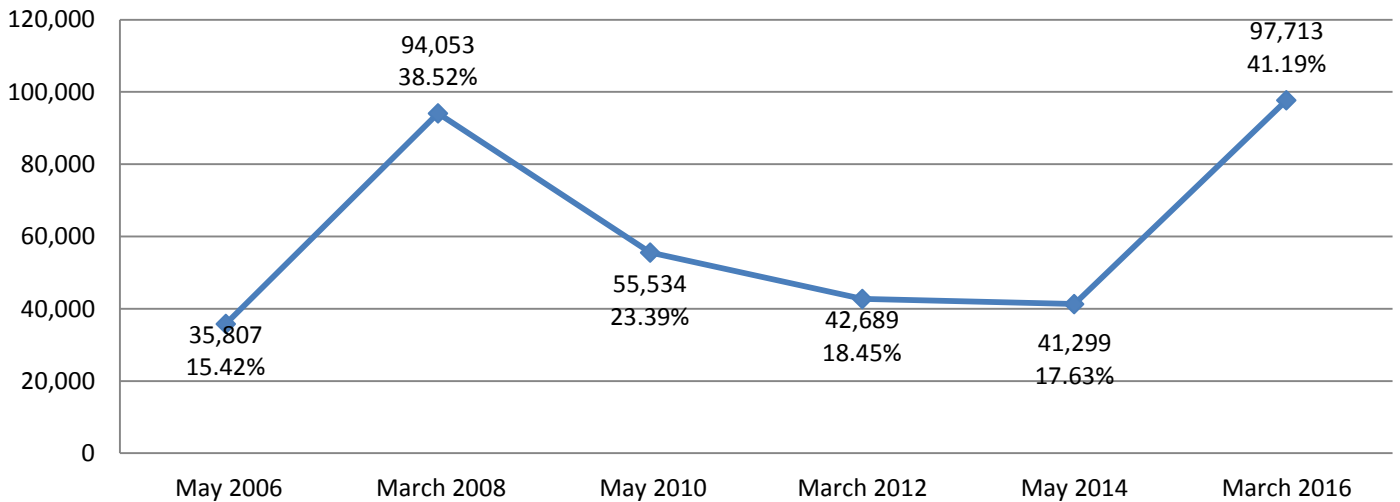

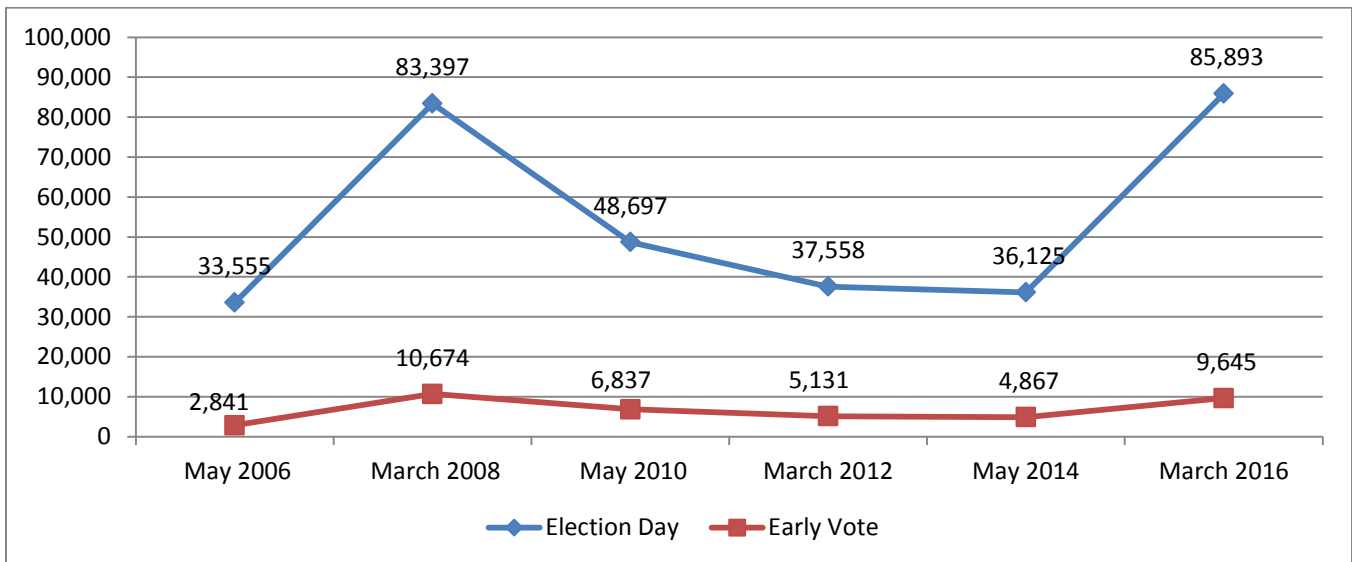
Voter Registration Trends in Even-Year Primary Elections: 2006-2016



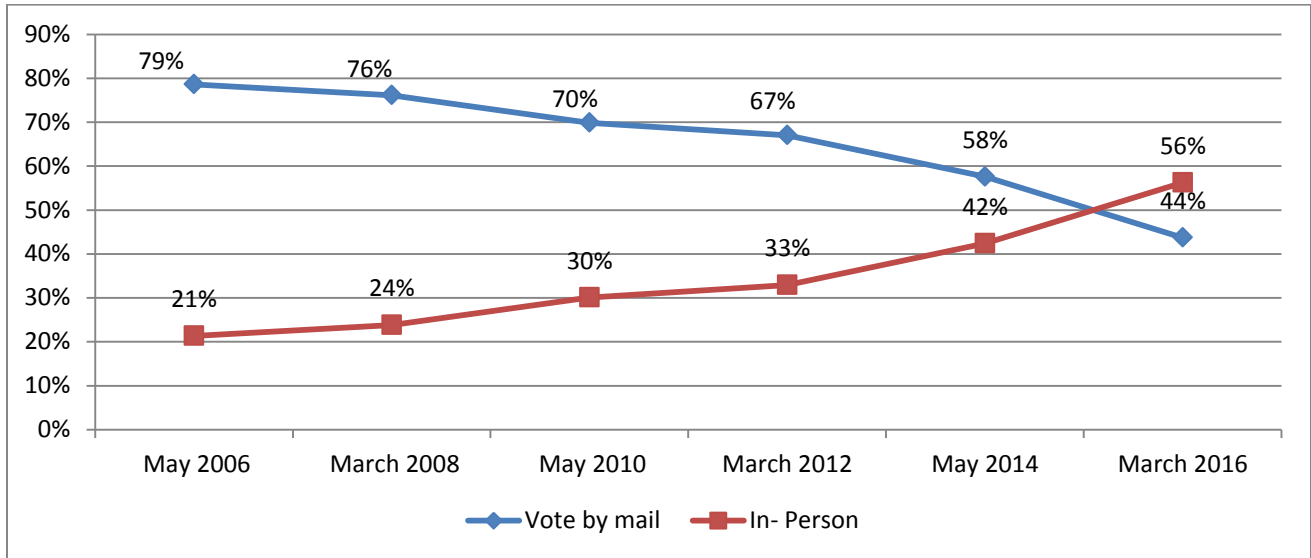
Election Turnout in Even-Year Primary Elections: 2006-2016



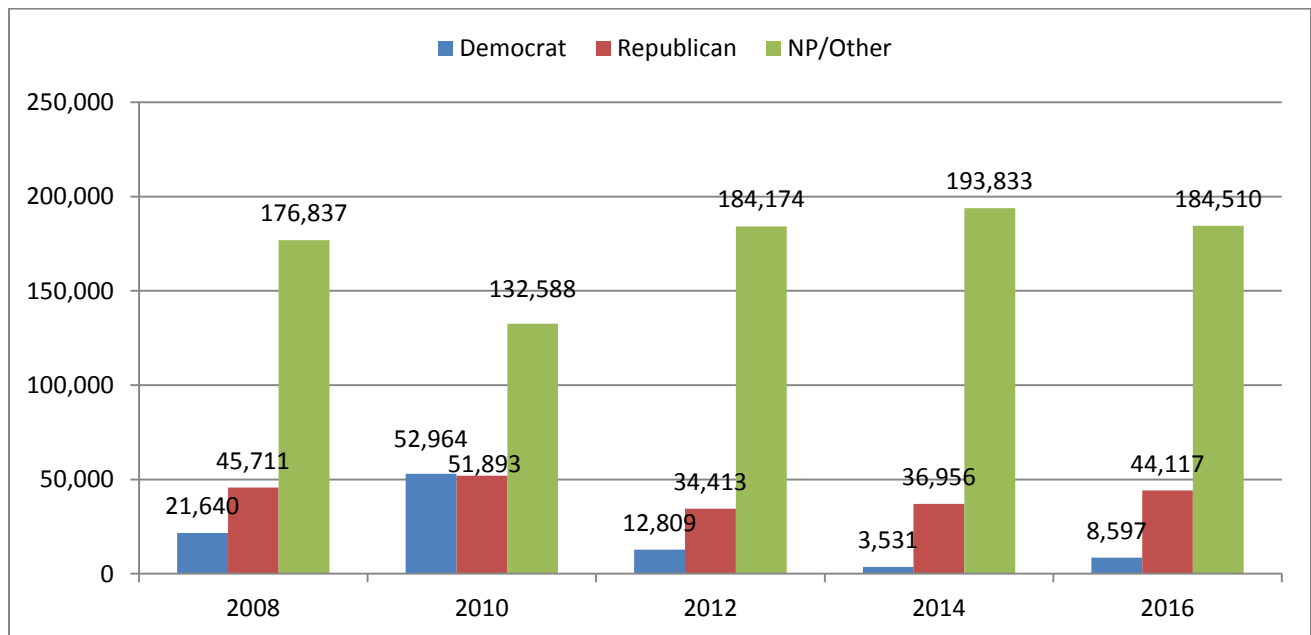
Early Voting Compared to Election Day Ballots in Even-Year Primary Elections: 2006-2016
