

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**
R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Township of Hanover of Hamilton, Ohio passed on the 4th day of August, 2016, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2016, the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of the Township of Hanover (unincorporated area) for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighter employers' contribution required under section 742.34 of the Revised Code, or the purchase of ambulance equipment, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company. Tax being a replacement of a tax of one and seventy five hundredths (1.75) and an increase of one and seventy five hundredths (1.75) mills to constitute a tax of three and five-tenths (3.5) mills at a rate not exceeding three and five-tenths (3.5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to thirty-five cents (\$0.35) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
