

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**
R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Members of the Board of Education of the Monroe Local School District of Monroe, Ohio passed on the 18th day of April, 2016, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2016, the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of the Monroe Local School District for the purpose of providing for the necessary requirements of the school district. Tax being a substitute tax of seven and two-tenths (7.2) mills at a rate not exceeding seven and two-tenths (7.2) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to seventy-two cents (\$0.72) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, with the sum of such tax to increase only and if and as new land or real property improvements not previously taxed by the school district are added to its tax list.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
