- Write your date of birth
- Write an identification number
 - The last four digits of your Social Security number (ex. 1234)
 - Your Driver's License number (ex. AA123456)
- Write the date of the election
 - May 8, 2018
- Select "Primary"
- Write the name of the political party ballot you wish to vote or select "Issues only ballot"**
 - Democratic
 - Green
 - Republican
 - Issues only ballot
- Sign your name
- Date your application
- Add your phone number and/or email address so we can contact you about your application if necessary



Don't forget this step! You must choose a party ballot or an issues only ballot.



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When will I get my ballot?

A: Tuesday, April 10, 2018 is the first day ballots will be mailed. If we receive your application after April 10, 2018 we will mail your ballot the same day it arrives at our office. Delivery usually takes 3-5 days.
