Board of Elections Releases Absentee Statistics for November 7, 2017 General Election - CORRECTION

HAMILTON, OH: A total of 8,744 voters have voted either by mail or in person in the November 7, 2017 general election. As of the close of in-person early voting this afternoon, a total of 4,387 voters voted in the office, slightly lower than the 4,615 early voters in the November 2015 general election. To date, 4,357 additional voters have voted absentee or by mail.

There are a total of 1,113 outstanding absentee and vote-by-mail ballots to be returned. Voters must return absentee ballots by mail with a postmark dated today or they may return their ballots in person to the Board of Elections office, 1802 Princeton Road, Hamilton, by close of polls at 7:30pm tomorrow, Election Day.

“Overall, early voting is slightly higher than two years ago, particularly due to higher vote-by-mail requests,” noted Director Diane Noonan. “In-person early voting also remained steady, and we anticipate around 30 percent turnout for the election.”
